ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



A Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) with a **minimum final grade of 101/110**. For degrees obtained abroad that do not include a final grade, the cumulative grade point average of completed courses will be considered and must be at least **equivalent to a B**, according to the University Academic Regulations conversion table for EU degrees or internationally recognized standards for non-EU degrees.

Certified **English language proficiency at B2 level** according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or an equivalent certification. The certificate must have been obtained within the four years preceding the application for the evaluation of prior academic qualifications.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Have obtained at least:

6cfu in the **socio-political science** and **anthropology** field

6cfu in the **economics** field

6cfu in the **legal** field

6cfu in the **history** field

10cfu in the **language** field

among FRAN-01/B, SPAN-01/C, ANGL-01/C, GERM-01/C, or other European or non-European languages that are not the candidate's native language. The CFU in the language field must have been obtained in at least 2 foreign languages, with a minimum of 5cfu per language.
